- * 22nd - 24th of January 2017: The thirty third (33rd) ordinary session of the Permanent Representatives Committee (PRC)
- * 25th- 27th of January 2017: The thirtieth (30th) ordinary session of the Executive Council
- * 30th-31st of January 2017: The twenty- eighth (28th) ordinary session of the Assembly of the Heads of State and Governments of the African Union.

The theme of the Summit is: ***“Harnessing Demographic Dividend through investments in the Youth”***

Journalists are invited to cover all the public sessions opened to the media. A detailed programme of the public events will be made available as soon as possible.
