# Call for Applications to the CSOs Intercontinental Forum 28 – 30 June 2017 Tunis, Tunisia Joint Africa – European Union Partnership Strategy (JAES)

#### **Background**

In an ever changing world, one thing is sure: Africa and Europe will remain each other's closet neighbours. Africa has been pursuing its political and economic integration at the continental level. From the foundation of the Organisation of African Unity (OAU) years ago and even more so since the creation of the African Union (AU), Africa has built continental institutions and established ambitious policies and initiatives in many key areas that both important for the development of the of the continent and of direct interest of the EU.
