# 17<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> November 2018: 11<sup>th</sup> Extraordinary Session of the Assembly of the Heads of State and Government of the African Union

Among other issues, the summit is expected to discuss: Update on the AU Institutional Reform process including reform of the AU Commission, mandate of the AU Development Agency (AUDA) and financing the African Union.

Journalists are invited to cover all the public sessions open to the media.
