we would like to inquire as to whether it would be acceptable for us to submit our bid over email instead of via courier, as the USA has been experiencing inclement weather in the south as well as many forest fires and we are concerned that it would delay your receipt of our bid. Please let us know whether you would find an email submission acceptable!	Email submission is not acceptable. Bidding document has to be submitted as per the instruction to bidders.
Please be kind enough to clarify whether the source of funds for this procurement is the Government of Turkey or the Government of Koweit? There seems to be a contradictory statement. In the bid document Section I, clause 1.1 "Source of Funds" the document states that the procurement is financed by the Government of Koweit. Whereas, in Section III, clause ITB 1.1 "INTRODUCTION" the bid document states that the funding for this procurement is provided by the Turkish Government.	Government of Turkish.
For the tender for the Night Vision goggles for 480 off, it mentions on page 58 of the document that it is Gen II+/III. However, there is no mention on the Figure of Merit (FOM) spec. Please clarify what you require as we can supply many different types.	The flexibility of stating either Gen 2+ or 3 was on prices versus quantity of what can be procured with the money available. But if we are to be specific:
Without this information we cannot bid!	NVGs should be Gen 2+; FOM may lie within range as follows: (basing on FOM=SNR x Resolution) Resolution range = 34-40 lp/mm; Signal to Noise Ratio (SNR) = 14.

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	Photosensitivity can be considered within specific range of 350-450 uA/lm.
As you are aware the heart of any night vision system is the image intensifier tube, which produces the image reflected in the reticle of the operator. The higher the performance of the tube, the pricier the system becomes and the clearer the image. In the bid document, namely in the Technical Specifications section, point d , gives a very generic and vague description of the tube requested, Gen II+/III image intensifier. This description equates to saying that one needs to buy a car with 4 wheels or a car with 4 wheels and a spare tire, without specifying the engine or the number of horsepower requested. Such a description will open the door for very low quality tubes offerings, and as a consequence, will hamper the operational capabilities of the African Union forces in the field, as they will be left with systems offering poor visibility. The image intensifier tube performance is measured in Figure of Merit (or FOM), the higher the FOM, the better the night time visibility. Therefore, in the benefit of the African Union forces and their safety, it is primordial to define the level of FOM requested in the technical specifications. Thank you for taking that comment into consideration and potentially adjusting the technical specification as a result.	See above
