The African Union Institute for Statistics (STATARIC) was created in January 2013 by the Africa Union (AU) Heads of States and Governments during the summit held in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. STATAFRIC is charged with a mandate to spearhead the provision and promotion of harmonized quality statistical information and good practice in support and monitoring of the implementation of the Agenda 2063 for the integration and development of Africa. The institute is responsible for steering the African Statistical System, build statistical capacity across the AU Member States and ensure provision of harmonized and aggregated statistical information needed to design, implement, monitor and evaluate African policies.

Statistics Botswana, therefore intends to broaden the statistical development and improve synergy within the Botswana National Statistical System Data Management Strategy and Coordination Framework.
