

Assessment of the Status of the Migration Governance Regime of Member States/RECs

In line with the AU Migration Policy Framework for Africa and Plan of Action (2018 – 2030) and the AU Technical Assistance Facility on Migration Governance, the AU Commission (in collaboration with the International Organization for Migration, , the United Nations High Commission for Refugees and GIZ) is conducting an «Assessment of the Status of the Migration Governance Regime of Member States/RECs». The assessment is targeted at those Member States that have requested for technical assistance or have received the 5-day training on migration governance under the AU Technical Assistance Facility on Migration Governance. The purpose of the assessment is to establish the status of migration governance in respective Member States/RECs to understand where technical assistance may be required. The assessment will be achieved through a questionnaire that will be administered to Member States, and upon which the Commission will prepare status reports on migration governance for each Member State. The country status reports will form the basis for engagement with migration stakeholders in each Member State during follow-up workshops that will be held later in the year.
