



African Union Summit on Industrialization and Economic Diversification 20th to 25th November 2022 Niamey - NIGER

GENERAL INFORMATION NOTE FOR PARTICIPANTS

INTRODUCTION

The AU Summit on Industrialization and Economic Diversification will be held from 20 to 25, November 2022 in Niamey, Niger, under the auspices of the Government of the Republic of Niger in collaborations with the African Union Commission and partners notably UNIDO, UNECA, AUDA-NEPAD and Afro-Champions Initiatives.

The African Union Summit on Industrialization and Economic Diversification aims to highlight Africa's renewed determination and commitment to Industrialization as one of the central pillars in attaining the continent's economic growth and development goals as articulated in Agenda 2063 and Agenda 2030.

The Summit is open to the participation of: African Heads of State; African Ministers responsible for industry, trade, mining and investment and other relevant ministries; Heads of international development institutions including the UN agencies; Chief Executives of Regional Economic Communities; Regional and International Development Finance Institutions; representatives of the private sector, civil society, youth, women, Investors, CEOs of Companies & Industries, Chamber of Commerce and other stakeholders involved in the industrialization of the continent.

The Summit is planned to be conducted into four levels that include sessions for the Ministers of Industry and Ministers of Economy, Sessions for Senior Officials; and Sessions for Heads of States as well as Private sector dialogue at the margins of the Presidential meeting.

With this dynamic preparation and mobilization of stakeholders, this information note provides participants that would like to take part in the Niamey meeting with information on the administrative and logistical organization, and on all the procedures put in place for the smooth running of this important event.

3. Summit Registration

Participants are requested to register online and obtain identification badges before the opening of the Summit.

Kindly, follow the summit website https://anec-niger.ne/events/61 to register by clicking on "Accreditation" on the home page

A badge collection counter will be open from November 10 to 22, 2022 from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. at the Gaweye hotel in Niamey.

The withdrawal of badges will be conditional on the presentation of a negative Rapid Screening Test (RDT), a negative PCR test or the COVID-19 vaccination Certificate.

Access to the Mahatma Gandhi International Conference Center and Palais des Congrès is strictly limited to delegates with appropriate badges.

It is highly recommended that delegates wear their accreditation badges visibly throughout the duration of the conference.

4. Entry Formalities in Niger

All visitors need a valid passport to travel to Niger. Entry visas can be obtained from Diplomatic and Consular representations of Niger abroad.

In case there is no Diplomatic or Consular representation of Niger in your country, an authorization to enter Niger (flying visa) must be obtained from the Nigerien authorities via the Niger Convention Agency (ANEC).

For this purpose, you must send a copy of your passport to the following address: accreditation@anec-niger.ne and indicate your country of origin, as well as your route. In this case, the visa will be issued to you upon your arrival at Diori Hamani International Airport in Niamey.

The Visa to Niger costs 25,000 CFA francs (38 euros) in cash and 2,500 CFA francs (3.8 Euros) for photo fees if you do not have one. Total Visa would cost 27,500 CFA (41.8 Euros).

Your passport will be held to affix the visa and it will be returned to you 24 hours later.

Holders of passports from the Economic Community of West African States (ECOWAS), Morocco, Mauritania, Chad, Tunisia, the African Union, the African Development Bank, and United Nations, do not need a visa to travel to Niger.

5. Airport Reception

On your arrival, Protocol and ANEC staff members will provide you with the necessary assistance. (Immigration formalities, Juggage delivery, transportation coordination and hotel transfers).

6. Transportation

The Government of Niger will make arrangements for the transport of participants from the airport to their hotels upon arrival in Niamey, and from the hotels to the airport upon departure from Niamey.

Participants can also hire vehicles from recommended private agencies, the list of which is attached.

7. Accommodation

Participants are requested to make their own reservations directly with the recommended hotels

When making the reservation, please specify that you are coming to attend the Industrialization Summit (NIGER) from November 20 to 25, 2022 in order to benefit from the reductions and facilities provided for this purpose.

8. Sanitary obligations

Vaccination against Yellow Fever is mandatory. Check the validity of your vaccination card, and update accordingly.

The presentation of the vaccination card on arrival at the airport is required by the border health team.

9. COVID-19 protocols

Participants are invited to follow the recommendations issued by the World Health Organization (WHO) regarding the prevention of COVID-19. However, the conditions for entering and leaving Niger by air are simplified as follows:

1. Travelers Arriving (disembarking):

- For vaccinated travelers whose last dose is at least 4 weeks old, the COVID-19 PCR test is no longer required;
- For travelers who have not been vaccinated or who have not provided proof of vaccination, the last dose of which dates back at least 4 weeks, the COVID-19 PCR test is required.

2. Departing Travelers (boarding)

- For any traveler presenting proof of vaccination for which the last dose dates back at least 4 weeks, the COVID-19 PCR test is no longer required.

- For any traveler who has not been vaccinated or who has not provided proof of vaccination, the last dose of which dates back at least 4 weeks, the COVID-19 PCR test is required.

Any participant showing symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, cough, headache, muscle pain) must isolate themselves as soon as possible in their room and notify the organizers who will inform the health protocol.

At the conference venue, participants must:

- Submit to systematic thermal control throughout the duration of the conference;
- Respect the wearing of the mask;
- Maintain social distancing;
- Constantly use disinfectant (hydroalcoholic gel), made available by the organizers;
- Samples for the COVID-19 PCR test at the time of departure can be taken at CERMES at 25,000 CFA francs, at the Mahatma Gandhi International Conference Center at 30,000 CFA francs. The results will be returned no later than 24 hours after the samples have been taken. For rapid tests with results the same day the amount is 50,000 FCFA.

If a participant is declared positive for COVID19, the Government will provide all medical care.

10. Working Languages

The working languages of the Conference will be English, French, Portuguese and Arabic.

Documents will be available in these languages and simultaneous interpretation will be provided during the proceedings.

11. Social and Leisure Program

The Government of Niger will offer a Gala dinner on November 24, 2022. Invitation cards will be given to those invited Guest.

A list of restaurants, tourist sites and other places of leisure is appended.

12. Currency and Banking Services

The monetary unit is the CFA Franc. The current exchange rate is 1 euro for 655.957 F CFA and 1 US dollar approximately 561 F CFA (as of September 2022).

Banks are open from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on weekdays and from 9 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. on Saturdays. All commercial banks provide banking services and different banks accept credit cards as follows:

- VISA
- MasterCard

Most internationally recognized currencies can be exchanged at commercial banks, and hotels.

13. Climate

The average temperature in Niger in November is between 30°C minimum and 35°C maximum.

14.Local hour

The local time in Niger is GMT + 1.

15. Administration Working Hours

The Administration Offices are open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. (Monday to Thursday); Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

16. Other useful information

Power supply

Niger uses 220/240Volts AC power supply.

It is advisable to bring your own two round plug adapter and a 110V AC transformer if required.



HEALTH PROTOCOL FOR THE ORGANIZATION of the Summit on Industrialization and Economic Diversification in Africa

1: Niger health guidelines for air transport in the context of COVID -19

2: Health system for the organization of the Summit on Industrialization and Economic Diversification in Africa

This system is led by a Health Commission supported by the General Management of the National Agency for the Economy of Conferences (ANEC). This Commission, under the chairmanship of the Office of the President of the Republic of Niger, is coordinated by the Director of Cabinet of the Ministry of Public Health.

The health system is developed in accordance with the guidelines of the World Health Organization (WHO) and the health regulations of Niger. The commission, in collaboration with the AU commission, ensures the effective implementation of the following actions:

1. Preventive actions before the holding of the AU session

- ✓ Dissemination of health documents on the ANEC and AU website one (01) month before the session is held;
- ✓ Reproduction and distribution of flyers on the management of COVID-19;
- ✓ Disinfection of the conference premises;
- ✓ Installation of disinfection equipment and barrier measures at all levels (airport, vehicles, hotels, restaurants, conference sites);
- ✓ Establishment of mixed teams for emergencies composed of Doctors, senior technicians in anesthesia-resuscitation, paramedics and first aiders) to provide on-call duty and permanence at the various sites;
- ✓ Constitution of drug kits distributed in ambulances, hotels, the General Reference Hospital and the Mahatma Gandhi International Conference Center;

- ✓ Deployment of medical ambulances at strategic conference sites (airport, hotels and conference venues);
- ✓ Installation of an infirmary on the main site of the Summit;
- ✓ Reservation of beds in hospitals (General Reference Hospital, National Hospital of Niamey);
- ✓ Establishment of an on-call and on-call system to maintain all skills on site;
- ✓ Carrying out the COVID-19 test for all drivers and protocol officers accompanying members of delegations;
- ✓ Mosquito control of accommodation and conference sites;
- ✓ Organization of simulation sessions.

Preventive actions on arrival (airport)

- ✓ The negative COVID-19 PCR test is one of the conditions for entry into Niger, the test must be valid for 72 hours from the date of the return of the result;
- ✓ Systematic check of passengers' health travel documents (negative COVID-19 test). These health documents must be translated into French or English. This control also concerns the international vaccination card (yellow fever);
- ✓ Systematic screening of all passengers including officials and diplomats;
- ✓ Verification of compliance with barrier measures at the airport (correct wearing of masks and respect for distancing);
- ✓ Thermal control, use of hydro alcoholic gel;
- ✓ Disinfection of luggage (bags and parcels in hand), baggage carousel, surfaces and cleaning of stairs and steps.

Preventive actions during transport

- ✓ Disinfection of vehicles including hotel shuttles;
- ✓ Installation of kits (masks, gel, handkerchief) in each vehicle;
- ✓ Respect for distancing in vehicles including hotel shuttles;
- ✓ All drivers and protocol officers accompanying delegation members will undergo the COVID-19 test.

Preventive actions at Hotel level:

- ✓ Regular disinfection of surfaces (rooms, reception, toilets, stairs, elevators, all other common rooms, etc.);
- ✓ Establishment of medical teams at hotel level;
- ✓ Temperature taking and use of hydro-alcoholic gel for all customers and visitors;
- ✓ Installation of a magnetic gel dispenser at the entrance to all common rooms;
- ✓ Mask wearing control;
- ✓ Respect for the distance at the reception, restaurant and conference rooms. A team will be provided for this purpose;
- ✓ Compulsory wearing of gloves for waiters and in restaurants.

Preventive actions at the summit venues:

- ✓ Regular disinfection of surfaces (rooms, toilets, stairs, lounges, restaurants, etc.);
- ✓ Systematic thermal control throughout the duration of the conference (thermal camera and thermo flashes);
- ✓ Establishment of permanent sampling teams for the COVID-19 Test at the Radisson Hotel (for Ministers and VIPs) and at the conference venue for other participants;
- ✓ Systematic control of mask wearing and distribution of masks to participants;
- ✓ Establishment of a permanent medical team for case management (malaise, cases tested positive and other illnesses);
- ✓ Respect for distancing in conference and committee rooms;
- ✓ Installation of a magnetic gel dispenser at the entrance to each common room;
- ✓ Installation of small format gel inside all work rooms;
- ✓ Respect for distancing during banquets, gala dinners and in restaurants, including the use of gel at the entrance.

Preventive actions at the start:

- ✓ COVI-19 PCR tests to be carried out on all participants before departure;
- ✓ Cost of the test: 60 US Dollars or 30,000 CFA francs payable cash in local currency, US Dollars or Euro;

- ✓ Samples for the COVID 19 PCR Test at the Radisson Hotel for Ministers and VIPs.
- ✓ Samples for the COVID-19 PCR Test at the Mahatma Gandhi International Conference Center for all other participants. A sampling schedule will be established according to the departure schedules of the participants.
- ✓ Results of the tests returned no later than 24 hours after the samples are taken;
- ✓ Control of the negative COVID-19 test before boarding;
- ✓ Control of mask wearing and use of hydro alcoholic gel;
- ✓ Free care until recovery at the Treatment Center in Niger if positive for COVID-19.

NB: Niger will provide free care for emergency cases and COVID-19 positive cases during the participants' stay.

Participants who wish to have health care outside the places designated by the Government must cover their treatment costs.
