EDUCATE AN AFRICAN FIT FOR THE 21ST CENTURY:

Building resilient education systems for increased access to inclusive, lifelong, quality, and relevant learning in Africa.

A concept note to spur PAU's engagement in the celebration of the Year on Education

1 Background and Rationale

- During the 36th Ordinary Session of the Assembly of Heads of States and Governments, the African Union adopted Education as the theme of the year 2024.
- The starting point of this milestone decision was the 2022 UN Transforming Education Summit, where AU Heads of States and Governments, attending a high-level side event under the leadership of the AUC Chairperson pledged to take up and address education challenges and gaps.
- A lot has been achieved by African governments to improve access and upgrade the quality of education services. These include reduced proportion of out-of-school children, better completion rates at primary and lower secondary education, improved access to pre-primary education, adult literacy, lifelong learning and school meals financing, but to name a few.
- However, education is still in deep crisis. Multiple attacks on schools, teacher shortages, low education outreach to marginalized groups such as girls, children in rural areas and those living with disabilities, are some of the compounding impediments to education progress in Africa.
- The official kick-off of the AU Theme of the year took place in Addis Ababa during the 37th Ordinary Session of the Assembly of AU Heads of States and Governments, in the presence of topranking officials from Regional Economic Communities, multilateral and bilateral partners, the diaspora and the media.
- With education at the continental limelight, key policy and decisionmakers will discuss the best ways to increase investments and designing acute policies to better advance the education agenda, especially towards the achievements of CESA 16-25 and SDG4 targets.

- Prior to this official kick-off, a prelaunch session was held under the leadership of the AUC Chairperson and the President of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia.
- Activities around the AU Education year are piloted by ESTI Department. A series of activities have already been implemented, in line with the Education Roadmap endorsed during the 37th AU Summit. These include the upcoming PAU Education Days.
- As the flagship academic institution of the African Union, the Pan African University will take advantage of this unique opportunity to further disseminate its objectives and achievements.
- The Pan African University envisions to become a leading centre of excellence in research and higher education for the advancement of Africa. It therefore aims at producing world class human resources through high-quality postgraduate education and research to drive the development imperatives of the continent to meet the aspirations of the Agenda 2063.
- The 2024 AU Year on Education comes when the Pan African University is currently in its consolidation phase, after an over decade-long launching phase. Moreover, less than two years ago, the PAU's 10th anniversary opened an opportunity not only to take stock of achievements recorded so far since its inception, but also to ponder on its most pressing challenges in the years ahead, including its financial sustainability.
- The 2024 Year on Education opens a space to bring the limelight to Education as a key priority in the Continent and therefore, highlight how PAU is contributing to foster higher education through the organisation of *PAU Education Days*. This Event is designed as a strategic gathering to enhance visibility and celebrate the

contribution of this pan African academic institution as a driving force for Africa's human capital development, and to connect with education stakeholders that could be interested in this project.
