Why: The Colloquium will provide a platform for candid exchange on

NEPAD as the African-owned development strategy adopted in 2001 to drive the Continent's political and socio-economic transformation. Thus, invited African Statesmen, Scholars, Nobel Laureates, Thought Leaders as lead discussants and development

practitioners will focus on:

• Examining the continued relevance and future of NEPAD as the African Union strategic framework for socio-economic development in the 21st Century.

- Assessing the contributions that NEPAD has made to Africa's transformation since its adoption in 2001;
- Exploring various strategic options of enhancing the implementation of the NEPAD vision
- Strengthening NEPAD and its Agency through increased advocacy, ownership and partnership amongst African peoples.

Objectives: The core objectives of the Colloquium are;

- To engage African stakeholders and partners towards enhancing ownership and the implementation of NEPAD as a flagship programme of the African Union at all levels;
- Raising awareness on NEPAD agenda and coalition building among a cross-section of Africans stakeholders;

- To serve as a open-ended platform for high-level discourse among prominent African Scholars and Thought Leaders on the forward looking approaches on implementation of Africa's development initiatives, notably the NEPAD Programme;
- To directly aggregate the viewpoints of African stakeholders on the strategic approaches and resources required to scale up the delivery for NEPAD through adequate sharing of knowledge, lessons learned and experiences;
- To popularize the work of NEPAD and related governance structures and institutions including the newly established NEPAD Planning and Coordinating Agency.
