BACKGROUND:

The UN Commission on Life-Saving Commodities for Women and Children aims to increase access to life-saving medicines and health supplies to save and improve the lives of millions of women and children worldwide. The Commission is part of the United Nations Secretary-General's initiative of "Every Woman Every Child movement" to support achievement of the health-related Millennium Development Goals (MDGs), launched on 23 March 2012 by the United Nations.

The Commission will produce a set of concrete recommendations for improving the accessibility of affordable, effective commodities for women's and children's health, with a focus on the needs of countries where the most women, newborns, and children under five die from preventable causes.
