Malaria at the Crossroads: high-level briefing at the sidelines of the African Union Summit

Event on Friday, 26 January co-hosted by the African Union Commission and RBM

Malaria efforts in Africa are at the crossroads. While some countries have seen a greater than 20% increase in malaria cases and deaths since 2016, others are showing that beating malaria is possible. According to the World Health Organization (WHO) *World Malaria Report 2017*, just 15 countries carried the heaviest malaria burden, together accounting for 80% of all malaria cases and deaths. All but one were in Africa. Held in conjunction with the African Union Summit, this high-level briefing seeks to create a watershed moment in global, regional and national efforts to end malaria on the African continent. It will explore a renewed and strengthened commitment to malaria elimination among African Union member States in 2018.
