Weekly Press Briefing on Coronavirus Disease Outbreak in Africa

INVITATION TO REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MEDIA

OVERVIEW: This briefing is a weekly engagement of the Africa Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (Africa CDC) with the media to share critical updates on the current state of the COVID-19 pandemic in Africa and the status of implementing the adapted Africa Joint Continental Strategy for COVID-19 Outbreak, including Africa CDC's response activities and the rollout of COVID-19 vaccines in AU Member States.

Thursday's briefing will highlight the evolving changes of the pandemic across the continent and focus on encouraging signs of increase in the number of available vaccines being distributed to Member States. Africa CDC support to national vaccination programs couple with partnerships aimed at supporting livelihoods in the countries will also be highlighted.
