# Weekly Press Briefing on Coronavirus Disease Outbreak in Africa

#### INVITATION TO REPRESENTATIVES OF THE MEDIA

**OVERVIEW:** This briefing is a weekly engagement of the Africa Centres for Disease Control and Prevention (Africa CDC) with the media to share critical updates on the current state of the COVID-19 pandemic in Africa and the status of implementing the adapted Africa Joint Continental Strategy for COVID-19 Outbreak, including Africa CDC's response activities and the rollout of COVID-19 vaccines in AU Member States.

The briefing on Thursday will focus on the usual epidemiological situation of COVID-19 and Africa CDC's recent efforts for easy travels across the continent, as well as updates on other out breaks being reported, including Monkey pox and Marburg. The director will further unpack the outcome of last week's meeting of the 41<sup>st</sup> Assembly of the Executive Council of the African Union which took place in Lusaka, Zambia.
