**WHAT**: <u>African Union Media Fellowship Programme (AUMF)</u> Media Roundtable under the theme 'The Future of Media in Africa: Shaping our Narratives.'

The Information and Communication Directorate's A.U. Media Fellowship Programme (AUMF), in partnership with Gordon Institute of Business Science's Media Leadership Think Tank and GIZ-AU, will host a Media Roundtable under the theme "The Future of Media in Africa: Shaping our Narratives" at the margins of the 37th African Union Summit.

The two-day event will bring together Media stakeholders to discuss issues on media ethics, responsible information sharing and revenue strategies to shape and advance African narratives, fostering a sustainable media ecosystem on the continent for the "Africa we Want". It will feature four (4) panel and roundtable discussions and four (4) Presentations spotlighting best practices and insights from industry specialists. AUMF Cohort 1 Fellows will showcase their work through articles, videos, and stories.
