

PRESS STATEMENT

The deputy Chairperson of the African Union Commission, HE Erastus Mwencha received HE. Beata Stelmach, Vice-Minister of Foreign Affairs in Poland Jacek Jankowsky accompanied by Mrs., Krzysztof Olendzki and Piotr Mysliwiec, respectively Ambassador of Poland to the African Union, Director of Africa and Middle East Department and Head of Division, Africa and Middle East Department at Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Poland.
