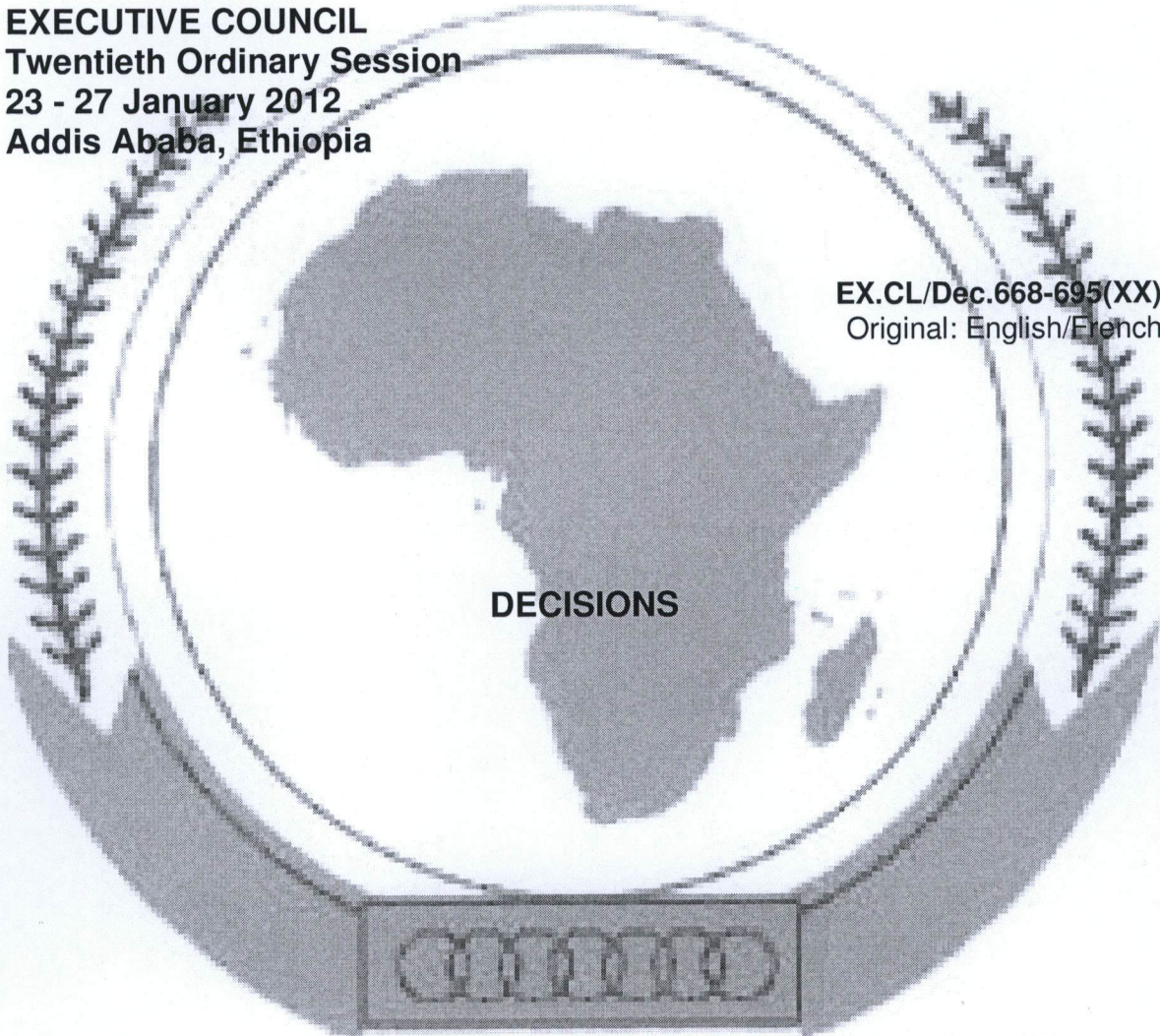

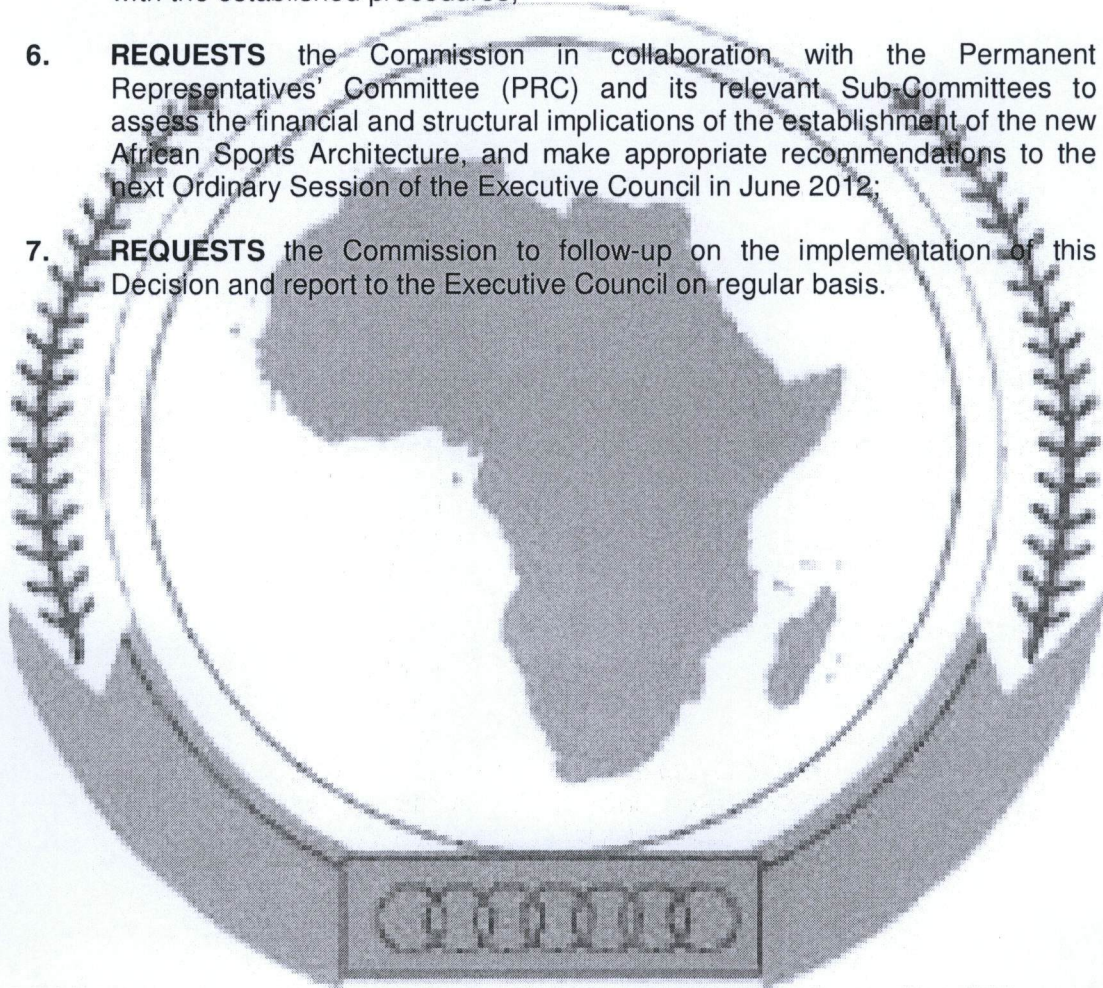
DECISIONS

**DECISION ON THE FOURTH SESSION OF THE AFRICAN UNION CONFERENCE
OF MINISTERS OF SPORT INCLUDING THE NEW SPORT
ARCHITECTURE FOR AFRICAN SPORT
Doc. EX.CL/697(XX)**

The Executive Council,

1. **TAKES NOTE** of the Report of the Fourth Session of the African Union Conference of Ministers of Sport (CAMS4) held in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia on 20 and 21 October 2011, including the New African Sport Architecture; and the recommendations contained therein;
2. **ENDORSES** the Report of CAMS4 and the recommendations of the Commission's Report on the establishment of a new African Sport Architecture and in particular that:
 - i) SCSA be dissolved at the end of the Extra-Ordinary Session of the General Assembly of SCSA scheduled to be held in Abuja, Nigeria in January 2012;
 - ii) The offer by the Federal Republic of Nigeria to host an Extra-Ordinary Session of the SCSA Assembly in January 2012 for the purpose of the final act of dissolution of SCSA be accepted;
 - iii) The offer by the Republic of Cameroun to host the Headquarters of the new African Sport Architecture also be accepted and that the Commission be requested to conclude a new Host Agreement with the Republic of Cameroun in this regard;
 - iv) Member States should offer all necessary assistance to the Commission, including an Administrator and other staff to be seconded at the expense of Member States for at least a period of two (2) years to facilitate a smooth transition and the integration of the functions of the SCSA into the Commission;
 - v) The All Africa Games be renamed as the "African Games";
 - vi) The ownership of the African Games be vested in the African Union and that the organization and management of the African Games be entrusted to the Association of National Olympic Committees of Africa (ANOCA) with technical inputs by the Association of African Sport Confederations (AASC); and
 - vii) The Commission be requested to conclude a Memorandum of Understanding with ANOCA;
3. **CONGRATULATES** the Republic of Mozambique for the successful hosting of the Tenth All Africa Games;

4. **ENDORSES** the elections of Egypt (Jan 2012 – Dec 2015), Botswana (Jan 2013 – Dec 2016), Ethiopia (Jan 2014 – Dec 2017), Gabon (Jan 2016 – Dec 2019), to serve on the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) Foundation Board and the election of South Africa (2012 – 2013) on the WADA Executive Committee. **ALSO ENDORSES** the Member State representing AU on the Executive Committee from 2013 as the Chairperson of CAMS as;
5. **WELCOMES** the offer by the Republic of Côte d'Ivoire to host the Fifth Session of CAMS in October 2013 at a date to be determined in accordance with the established procedures;
6. **REQUESTS** the Commission in collaboration with the Permanent Representatives' Committee (PRC) and its relevant Sub-Committees to assess the financial and structural implications of the establishment of the new African Sports Architecture, and make appropriate recommendations to the next Ordinary Session of the Executive Council in June 2012;
7. **REQUESTS** the Commission to follow-up on the implementation of this Decision and report to the Executive Council on regular basis.

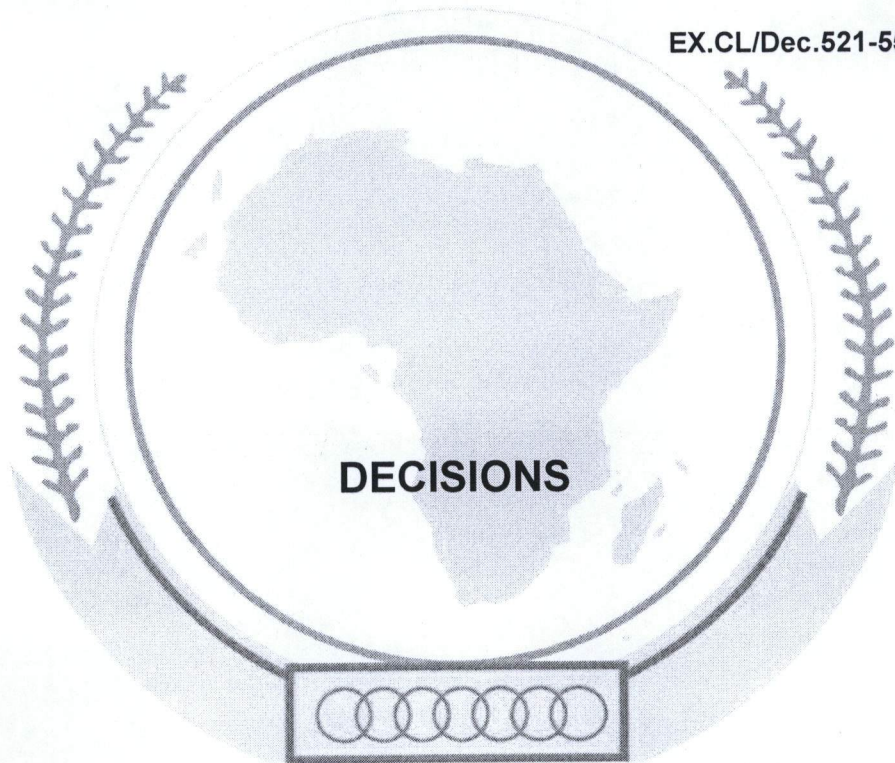

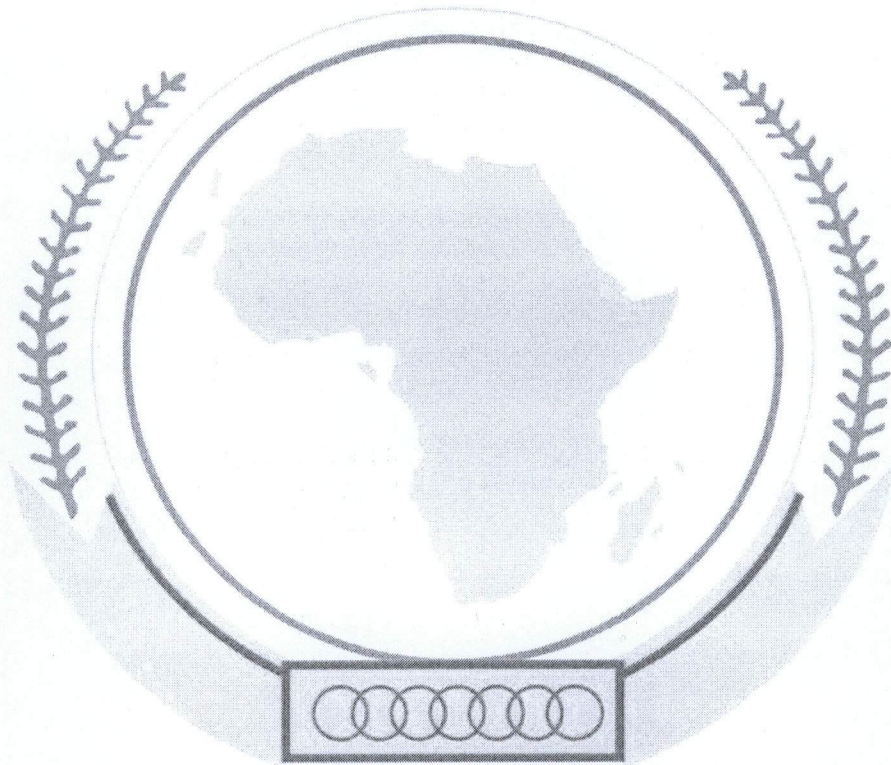
**DECISION ON THE REPORT OF THE THIRD SESSION OF THE AFRICAN
UNION CONFERENCE OF MINISTERS OF SPORTS (CAMS3)
Doc. EX.CL/557(XVI)**

The Executive Council,

1. **TAKES NOTE** of the Report of the Third Ordinary Session of the African Union Conference of Ministers of Sports (CAMS 3), held in Abuja, Nigeria, from 12 to 16 October 2009 and the recommendations contained therein;
2. **ENDORSES** the recommendations of CAMS 3, in particular, the following:
 - i) A new Architecture for African Sports, consisting of the current Conference of Ministers of Sports (CAMS) and its Bureau to provide political leadership in the domain of sports, and a Sports Advisory Board with Technical Committees to prepare issues for discussion and decision for the CAMS meetings;
 - ii) The Commission should conduct further studies regarding the integration of the functions of Supreme Council for Sports in Africa (SCSA) into the Commission, including the transitional mechanism and the current financial situation relating to SCSA and submit the outcome to the Permanent Representatives Committee (PRC) through the relevant Sub-Committees, including the Structures Sub-Committee; and the Sub-Committee on Administrative, Budgetary and Financial Matters;
 - iii) Dissolution of the SCSA to be concluded after the next All Africa Games to be held in Mozambique, in 2011.
3. **URGES** Member States to pay their contributions and arrears to the SCSA in order for SCSA to fulfill its financial obligations before its dissolution, and **DECIDES** that the Commission should be fully involved in the dissolution programme for SCSA;
4. **WELCOMES** the Report by the Republic of South Africa on the progress towards hosting the 2010 FIFA World Cup event and **CALLS ON** Member States to participate and fully support South Africa in this regard;
5. **DECIDES** that the theme for Africa Day 2010 should be *"Building and Maintaining Peace through Sports in Africa"*;
6. **FURTHER CALLS ON** Member States to fully support the African participating teams from Algeria, Cameroon, Cote d'Ivoire, Ghana, Nigeria and South Africa;
7. **CONGRATULATES** the Republic of Ghana for winning the Under-20 FIFA World Cup, the Arab Republic of Egypt and the Federal Republic of Nigeria for successfully hosting the Under-20 and Under-17 FIFA World Cup events, respectively; and the Republic of Angola for successfully hosting the 27th African Cup of Nations;

8. **WELCOMES** the offer by the Arab Republic of Egypt to host the Fourth Session of the CAMS in 2011;
9. **RECOMMENDS** that the dates of the final phase of the World Cup scheduled to take place in South Africa in 2010 be taken into account in fixing the dates of the next African Union Summit in June/July 2010;
10. **REQUESTS** the Commission to follow up on the implementation of the outcomes of CAMS 3 and report thereon to the next Ordinary Session of the Executive Council in July 2010.

DECISION ON THE REPORT OF THE SECOND SESSION OF THE AFRICAN
UNION CONFERENCE OF MINISTERS OF SPORT
Doc. EX.CL/472 (XIV)

The Executive Council:

1. **TAKES NOTE** of the Report of the Second Session of the African Union Conference of Ministers of Sport (CAMS II), held in Accra, Ghana, from 10 to 14 October 2008;
2. **ENDORSES** the recommendations of the Ministerial Conference, in particular, the following:
 - i) dissolution of the Supreme Council for Sports in Africa (SCSA);
 - ii) implementation of the Code on the Relations between Governments, National and International Sports Organisations;
 - iii) dissemination and popularization of the Policy Framework for the Sustainable Development of Sports in Africa.
3. **CALLS ON** Member States to support the Republic of South Africa in the 2010 FIFA World Cup event, and to take full advantage of the promotional and socio-economic opportunities that the event would offer to Member States and the Continent;
4. **WELCOMES** the offer by the Federal Republic of Nigeria to host the Third Session of the AU Conference of Ministers of Sport in 2009;
5. **REQUESTS** the Commission to follow-up on the implementation of the outcomes of the Conference and report thereon to the Executive Council.
