Article 26A of the **African Youth Charter** charges youth to take ownership of their own development.

The Africa Youth Charter also proclaims November 1st as Africa Youth Day. This year, within the context of the 1 Million By 2021 initiative, the AUC is celebrating **the entire month of November** as **Africa Youth Month**, under the theme **"Youth Voices, Actions, Engagement: Building A Better Africa"**
