III. Liaison Officers

IV. Arrival Ceremony and Procedure

A. Ministers of Urban and Infrastructure, Mayor of Ethiopian Cities, Ministers

• Ministers will be received by Officials of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs on their arrival.

B. Other Participants

- Protocol Officers of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs will receive delegates.
- The Officers will operate from both VIP and normal passenger arrival lounges and assist participants.

V. Visa and Customs

Visa Formalities

- > Participants must complete all immigration procedures to enter Ethiopia.
- ➤ Delegates and other Participants holding Diplomatic and Service Passports are permitted to enter without a visa if there is a visa waiver agreement between Ethiopia and their respective Countries (Kindly check your country statute the list on the immigration website or your home Ministry of Foreign Affairs prior to your trip or below Contact Persons for visa-related issues). The Concerned

delegates do not need to apply for visa to travel to Ethiopia. They will receive upon arrival at immigration an entry stamp.

- ➤ For holders of Diplomatic, Service, or Ordinary passports of States or AU and UN Laissez-passer, a Visa on Arrival can be issued at the Addis Ababa Bole International Airport upon presentation of an invitation letter from the AU and or , FDRE Ministry of Urban and infrastructure prior submission of a formal request along with a list of participants to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- ➤ However, all participant for the Forum holding ordinary passport must apply for Conference Visa online at https://www.evisa.gov.et/visa using the following Company Reference No: MI1795601045611 at a discounted fees of Only 52 USD 72 hours before arrival and present the printout of their application along with an invitation letter to easily process their visa process on their arrival at Bole International Airport. To avoid any inconvenience when processing visas, delegations, and journalists are recommended to present an invitation letter from the organizer while applying online.
- → Dedicated immigration counters shall be reserved for participants of the Africa Urban Forum at the normal passenger terminal of the Addis Ababa Bole International Airport to provide fast-track visa service for participants of the summit.
- ➤ In addition to the above information, participants coming from countries that host Ethiopia Embassy are advised to apply for a visa from such Ethiopia Embassy in their proximity.
- N.B. For purposes of issuing visas, passports should be valid at least for the next six months.

Customs Regulations

For Incoming Passengers

A) Prohibited Items

- Narcotic drugs, Stimulants, Psychotropic substances, etc.
- Drones and Satellite Equipment
- Firearms such as pistols, revolvers, machine guns, and bullets or parts thereof
- Explosive, Gunpowder, Materials for chemical weapons, Germs such as anthrax, etc.
- Counterfeit, Altered or Imitated Coins, bank notes or securities, and forged credit cards.
- Obscene or immoral materials and child pornography.
- Articles that infringe upon intellectual property rights (patent, utility, model, design, trademark, copyright, etc.)

C) Duty- Free Allowed Items

- One Laptop Computer
- 2 bottles of alcoholic beverages
- Cigarettes: 2 packets
- 600ml of perfume

D) Temporary Importation

- To comply with the import customs regulations of the Government of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia, participants should **declare** the following items they may bring with them into the country: -
 - Laptops (if there is more than one);
 - Desktop Computer, Printer, Scanner, Video Cameras, etc...

Any other Forum and Exhibition equipment

- To be assisted with the temporary importation of the above items, participants should send the detailed specifications of the items to be brought in to the Secretariat of the Protocol and logistics arrangements of the Forum and Exhibition by the 20th of August 2024 at the latest.
- The items will be registered for temporary import by the customs office and they will be taken out of the country at the end of the Forum and Exhibition.

E) Declaration of Goods and Cash

• Participants are highly advised to declare items stated in A and B and goods that exceed duty-free allowance as per C.

• Similarly, cash, the amount that <u>exceeds USD 10,000.00</u> or its equivalent, or precious metals weighing above 100 grams should be declared to the customs office at the airport. Declaration of the said items upon arrival will avoid hustle during departure.

N.B. To declare personal effects, an application form is attached. (See Annex IX)

VI. Members of the Press and Press Equipment

- ➤ The list of members of the press and their professional equipment to be brought into the country should be communicated to the Protocol Directorate General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Ethiopia as per the application form. (See Annex IV).
- A special Desk from the Ethiopian Media Authority Office shall be reserved at the airport to provide fast service for Journalists coming to cover the Forum.
- ➤ It is strongly advisable for journalists to arrive one and a half hours before the meetings start.

X. Security

The Government of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia will provide 24-hour security service during the Forum and at all venues and hotels where delegates will be staying as well as during their movements.

- Participants are required to follow advice and guidance from ushers, security officers, and protocol staff.
- No firearms/weapons are allowed in the meeting premises.

Security Fire Arms and Communication Equipment

Permission and Clearance

It should be noted that Delegations led by Ministers or others are allowed to bring only two side arms.

- Firearms to be brought into Ethiopia must get permission 72 hours before the Delegation from the Protocol Directorate General of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- All firearms should be declared at the Airport upon arrival and departure. (See Annex I)

- Except for the Ministers, all delegates will be subjected to security checks when accessing the Forum Halls.
- Communication equipment to be used by security officers should get permission 72 hours before entering the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia. Hence, each Mission is advised to submit the duly completed form to the Secretariat at least a week ahead of arrival. (See Annex II)
- N.B. The protection officers with the side arms shall stay inside their vehicles or in shelters designated for this purpose.

Customs Regulations for Outgoing Passengers

A) Prohibited Items

- Inscription of Skin, Ivory, Horn, Archeological and Bone.
- Written and Graphic Historic documents.
- Ethnographic Implements.
- Paleontological, Paleo-Anthropological, and Archeological findings like Fossils, Stone tools, and Pottery.
- Ornaments, Authority rings or Stamps, Stone Inscriptions, and Ancient Coins.
- Historic Objects like Costumes, Crowns, Scepters, Thrones and Medals.
- Utensils and Furniture of ex-Royal families.
- Historic Armaments like Pistols, Rifles, Shields, Spears/ Swords.
- Musical Instruments (contemporarily out of production).
- Ancient and Historic memorial and Religious objects like Parchments, Crosses, Paintings, other Churches' Ceremonial objects.
- Ethnographic objects like Domestic and Kitchen materials,
 Headrests, Burial marks, Techno-history objects (considered to be the first generations of their type), and Museum Objects.
- Drug and narcotic substances.
- Explosives and weapons.

C) Limits of Currencies not to be taken out of the Country

- More than **ETB 3,000.00**
- Undeclared foreign currency amounting to more than **USD 10,000.00** or its equivalent value in any currency.
- If a person is found having beyond the permitted amount of currency, the money will be confiscated by the Airport Customs and the person will be liable before the law. That is why the law requires declaring an amount more than USD 10,000 or its equivalent upon arrival at the Customs Authority at the Bole International Airport. Such action will prevent any hustle during departure.
- Ethiopian coins and notes that bear the Millennium logo.

- ➤ Languages Ethiopia is a multi-ethnic state with a great variety of languages spoken. Amharic is the official working language of the Federal Government. English is the widely spoken international language in Ethiopia.
- ➤ Time GMT+3
- ➤ International Dialing Code +251
- ➤ Electricity supply 220V
- ➤ Telecommunication service Ethio-Telecom and Safaricom are the telecommunication service providers in Ethiopia.
- ➤ Currency and Banking The Currency of Ethiopia is Birr. It is divided into 200, 100, 50, 10, 5, 1 banknotes and 1, .50, .25, .10, .05, .01 cents. One United States Dollar is approximately equivalent to 101 Birr (Differs daily).

- ➤ Major Banks have a cash dispenser (ATM), accepting Visa and Master Cara d.
- Foreign currencies can be exchanged at banks only. Exchanging foreign currency outside the bank and transactions in foreign currency is illegal in Ethiopia.
- ➤ **Banking Hours** Banks are open from 8:00 AM to 7:00 PM from Monday to Saturday.
- ➤ **Shopping Hours** –Shops are generally open from 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM from Monday to Saturday. They are mostly closed on Sundays.
- ➤ Calendar Ethiopia uses a Julian calendar, which divides the year into 12 months of 30 days each. The remaining five or six days in a leap year constitute the short 13th month known as "Pagume". The Ethiopian Calendar is seven years behind the Gregorian calendar, with the Ethiopian New Year falling on the 11th of September.
- ➤ Weather Ethiopia is mostly covered by the Ethiopian Highlands and generally has a climate cooler than other countries in the same region. Addis Ababa, the capital city is situated at a high altitude of around 2,400 m (7,874 ft). The average annual temperature in Addis Ababa is 16 °C (60.8 °F), with daily maximum temperatures averaging 20–25 °C (68.0–77.0 °F) throughout the year. The overnight temperature is generally low averaging 5–10 °C (41.0–50.0 °F).
- ➤ July falls within the rainy season with temperatures between 12–16 °C lowest and 22–26 °C highest. The temperatures usually suddenly drop after rain.
- ➤ Environment and Biodiversity Ethiopia is the fourth largest biodiversity zone on earth with several endemic plants and animals, and 850 species of birds of which around 15 of them are endemic. Ethiopia boasts landscapes of stunning beauty and dramatic contrasts from the soaring pinnacles of the Simein Mountains roof of Africa- to the plummeting depths of the Danakil depression, the lowest, and hottest place on earth. Cloud forests such as those in the Kafa Biosphere Reserve- the sole home of

many wild coffee varieties- active volcanoes, hot springs, cool underground Caverns, rugged gorges, waterfalls, lakes, and rivers. The largest, Lake Tana, is the source of life nurturing the Blue Nile.

> Ethiopian Legislative Framework that Governs Access to Genetic Resources;

> To promote the conservation and sustainable utilization of the country's biological resources and also ensure a fair and equitable share of benefits arising from the use of genetic resources, the Government of the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia has put in place a legal framework that governs access to genetic resources. (See Annex VII for details)
