Focal Persons Trained on Monitoring, Evaluation and Reporting Tools

Adama – Nazareth, 20th February 2012: A four –day Capacity Building Training commenced today to equip participants with a clear understanding on formulation and monitoring of programs, performance indicators and reporting. The training will end on 23 February 2012.



The main objective of this training is to allow the African Union Commission (AUC) to monitor the outcome of its projects/program activities and provide a worthwhile report to Member States as well as international partners giving emphasis on Results /achievements at different level.

According to Mr. Jacques Mukwende, Ag. Head of Int'l Cooperation & Resource Mobilization of the AUC, who officially opened the training, one extra day, will be dedicated to focus on two particular AUC Programs, which are under joint Program Arrangements (JPAs) namely Capacity Building and Shared Values.

At the end of this four –days training, it is expected that participants drawn from different departments of the AUC, will be equipped with Projects design skills, formulation of Projects performance indicators and Reporting tools.



The training is being conducted by two South Africa based companies jointly, Innodev and WYG International, that have vast experience in establishing Monitoring and Evaluation frameworks and capacity building in some of the Regional Economic Communities (RECs) namely SADC and COMESA.
