This is the AU's year of Human Rights with Particular focus on the Rights of Women. Africa stands united for zero tolerance on violence against women and the full protection of the rights of all people including me.

On the margins of the 27th AU Summit, on July 8 & 9, 2016 Kigali, Rwanda- will host the 3rd AU High Level Panel on Gender Equality and Women's Empowerment. Under the leadership of H.E President Paul Kagame and H.E Dr. Nkossazana Dlamini Zuma, African Ministers, experts, scholars, practitioners, CSOs, think-tanks and delegates from the AU will deliberate on the theme "The Contributions of Maputo Protocol on Women's Rights in Transforming Gender Roles in Africa: Stocktaking, Opportunities and Accountability".
