



Statement of the Chairperson of the African Union Commission on the political agreement reached in Sudan on 21 November 2021

Addis Ababa, 21 November 2021: The Chairperson of the African Union Commission, Moussa Faki Mahamat, has learned with satisfaction of the signing of the agreement reached between the President of the Sudanese Supreme Council, Abdel Fatah Al Burhan, and Prime Minister, Abdalla Hamdock, today, 21 November 2021.

The Chairperson commends this important step towards the return to constitutional order as enshrined in the Khartoum agreements of August 19, 2019, which frame the consensual and democratic transition in Sudan.

He encourages all political and social, civil and military actors to deepen this orientation and to implement it inclusively and effectively, in a climate of peace and national reconciliation.

The Chairperson of the Commission calls on the international community to renew its commitment in solidarity with Sudan so that it regains peace and prepares, in a democratic consensus, for regular and free elections, which are the only path to put a definitive end to the institutional turmoil in the country and ensure its sustainable development.
