



Statement on the Chairperson of the African Union Commission working visit to Sudan

14 February 2022, Addis Ababa: The Chairperson of the African Union Commission, Moussa Faki Mahamat, paid a working visit to Sudan from Saturday 12 to Monday 14 February 2022.

During the visit, the Chairperson met most of the political and social, civil and military actors. The meetings made it possible to consider, in a spirit of openness and frankness, the particularly sensitive situation which threatens the country with serious political, security and economic perils.

The Chairperson and his delegation were received with fraternal warmth by all the interlocutors who discussed all aspects of the situation in the country with frankness and sincerity, including ways and means of solving its complex crisis, so as to ensure the restoration of Constitutional civil order in the service of peace, stability and development.

The Chairperson also met with the Special Representative of the UN Secretary General in Sudan and the Troika.

During the visit, the Chairperson reaffirmed the relevant fundamental principles of the AU and its commitment to the solution of African problems by Africans, in close cooperation with international partners, in particular the United Nations, in accordance with an approach respectful of such principles and of the sovereignty of the Sudanese people in dealing with their own affairs.
