This consensus Action Plan will be submitted for Ministers of the two regions for consideration and adoption, at an extra-ordinary meeting.

The Theme chosen for our Summit "Together for Sustainable Development and Economic Cooperation;" is timely and appropriate in that it reminds us of the need to work together more than ever to achieve Agenda 2063 and Arab Action Plan on Sustainable Development.

In this direction, I wish to once again confirm the readiness of the African Union to fulfill its commitments and work together with the League of Arab States to fully implement the agreed upon joint programs and projects, in a balanced and integrated manner; and work towards eradicating poverty in all its forms and dimensions.
